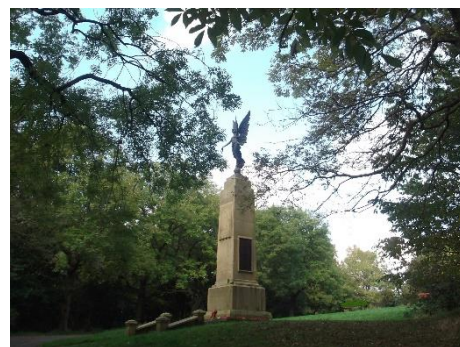

with walk around the Lake carrying out our Weekly Waterbirds Survey

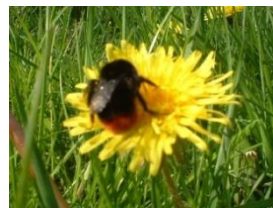

Boggart Hole Clough & adjacent Bailey's Wood are *Ancient Semi-Natural Woodlands* described by Natural England as "irreplaceable" & of "prime ecological & landscape importance." Ecologists report these woodlands to be in an "unfavourable condition" as are other aspects of the area.

We monitor the area's wildlife habitats, identify & map fauna & flora species, research, discuss & promote **restoring biodiversity health**, & campaign for employment of a team of properly paid & trained Conservationists to carry out this essential work.
